### OPENING ACCLAMATION

*Priest* The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, be with you all.      *People* **And also with you.**

### CONFESSION

We have not loved you with our whole heart, we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent. For the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your name. Amen.

*Priest offers absolution. For personal devotions, you may pray,*

Almighty God have mercy on me, forgive me my sins through the grace of Jesus Christ,  
strengthen me in all goodness, and by the power of the Holy Spirit keep me in eternal life. Amen.

### CLOSING PRAYER – *in unison*

May God, who goes before us through desert places by night and by day, be our companion and guide; may our journey be with the saints; may the Holy Spirit be our strength, and Christ our clothing of light, in whose name we pray. Amen.

### BLESSING

May the One who creates and restores everything that is bring you compassion and peace, hope and joy. And may the blessing of God Almighty, our Creator, Redeemer and Sustainer, be with you now and always. Amen.
